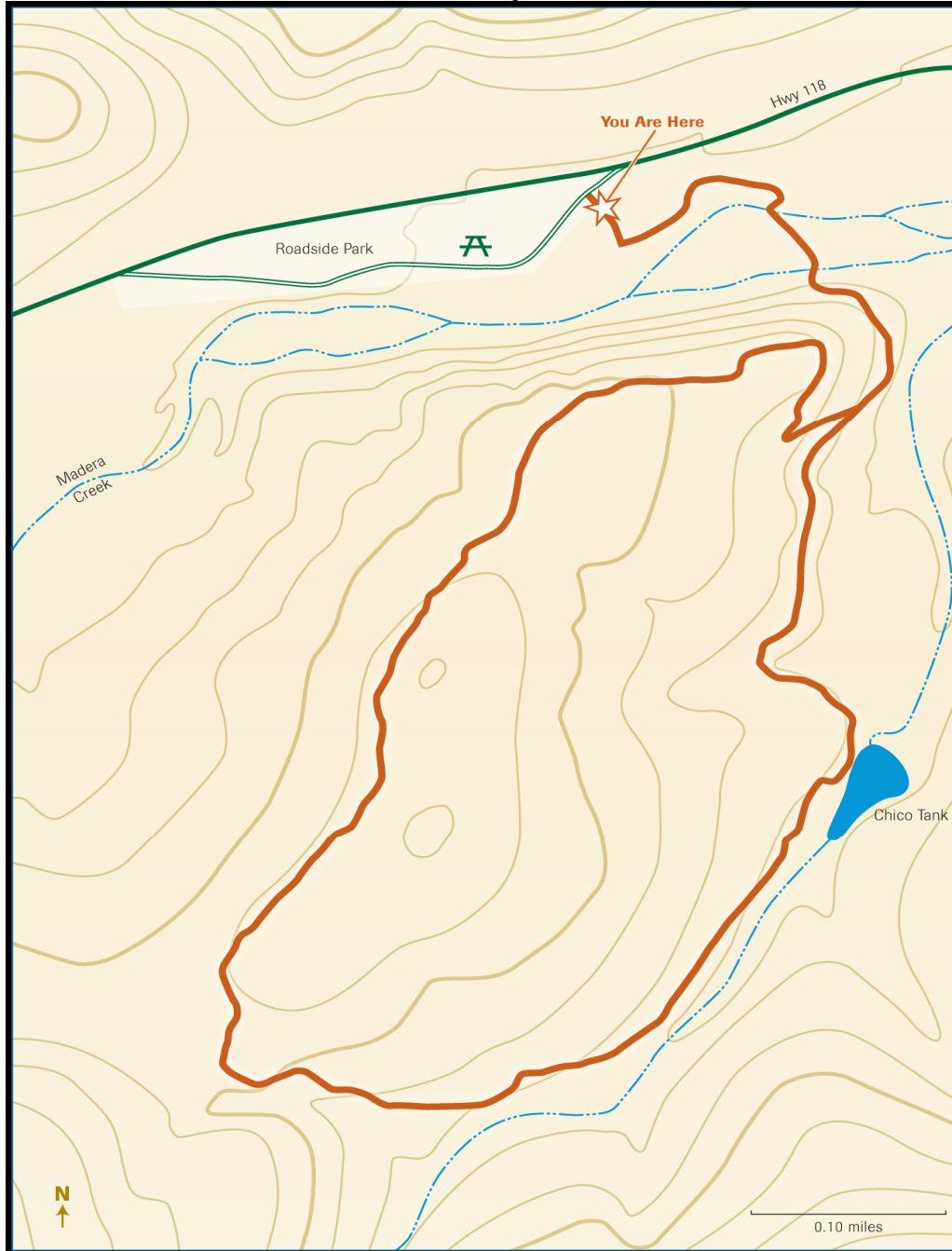


Madera Canyon Trail



The Madera Canyon Trail is a 2.4 mile loop through part of The Nature Conservancy's Davis Mountains Preserve.

Please Remember

- You are a guest on private property so stay on the trail
- Foot traffic only
- No pets
- Leave what you find
- No camping
- Take care of the trail so that others can continue to enjoy it

The trail winds through pinyon-oak-juniper woodlands to a scenic view of 8,300 foot Mount Livermore as well as a view of Madera Canyon.

Directions: The trail head is at the Lawrence E. Wood picnic area on Hwy 118 about 10 miles north of the McDonald Observatory. A wooden split-rail fence marks the trail head on the east side of the picnic area.
